Metrics with No Updates

- By 2019, increase the percent of pre and postnatal women who had a dental visit from 55.2% to 60%.

- By 2019, increase the percent of children 6-14 years who received a dental sealant to 20%.
 - SOURCE: OHA/EPSTDT, 2015
- By 2019, decrease the percent of 1st and 2nd graders who untreated dental decay in schools that participate in the School Dental Sealant Program by 5%.
 - SOURCE: School Dental Sealant Program, 2013-14
- By 2019, increase the percent of children 0-5 years who received a dental service within the reporting year to 40%.
 - SOURCE: PRAMS, 2011

Updated Metric

- By 2019, decrease the percent of 8th graders who missed one or more hours of school do to going to the dentist because of tooth or mount pain by .5%
