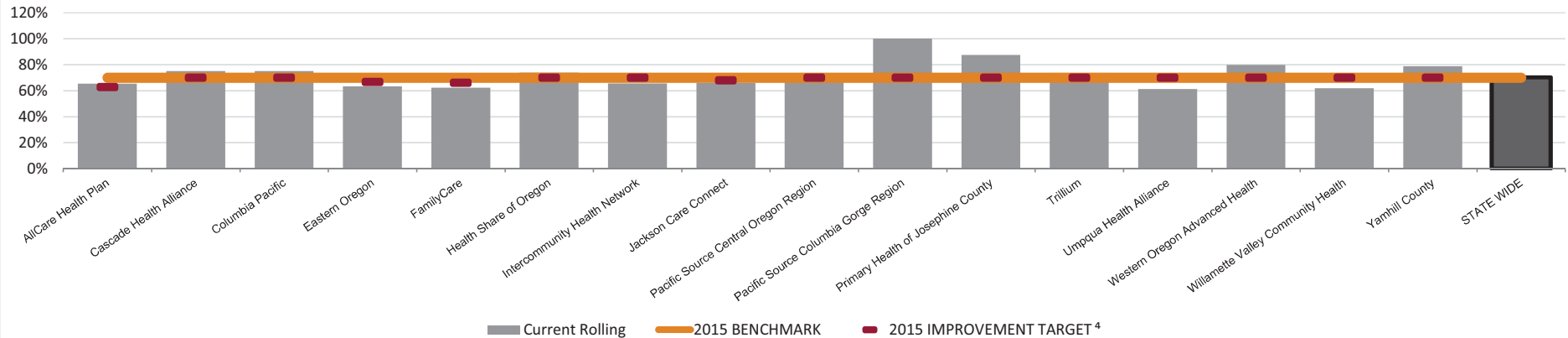

This measure addresses an emerging issue for children by suggesting follow up for patients ages 6 and up. Additionally, research shows that follow-up care helps keep patients from returning to the hospital, providing an important opportunity to reduce health care costs and improve health.</p>

*** Follow Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (7-Day)**



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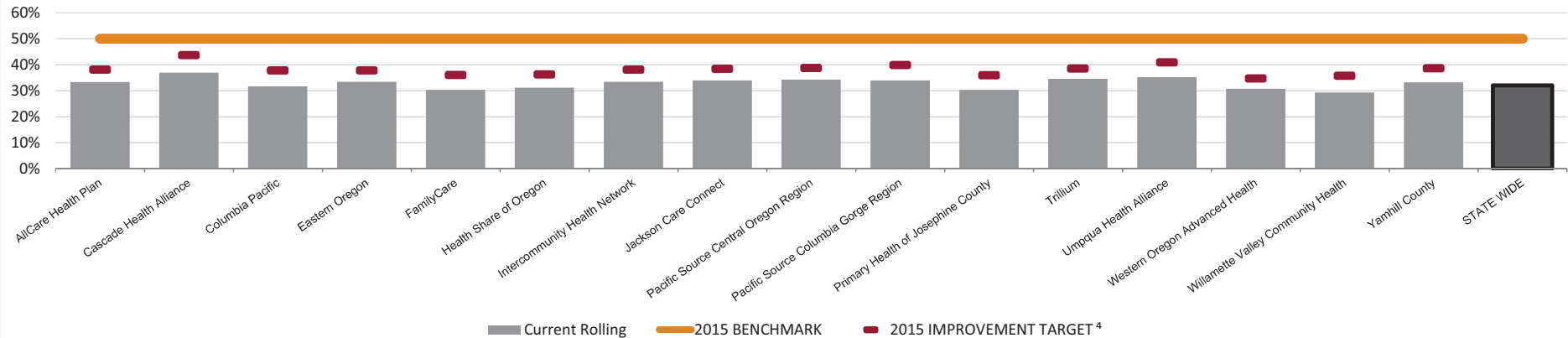
