

2023 COHC Opportunity Grant

The Central Oregon Health Council (COHC) is committed to creating a healthier future for Central Oregonians. We are recognizing the ongoing support organizations are seeking to sustain current programming and program development to advance innovation and transformation in healthcare. We have an opportunity grant available for organizations that are aligned with our <u>Future State Measures</u> listed in the <u>Regional Health Improvement Plan</u> (<u>RHIP</u>). This will provide opportunities to improve the health and well-being in our region.

About the Fund

2023 COHC Opportunity Grant is open to organizations who have been awarded funding from other grantors and whose project aligns with the RHIP Future State Measures. The amount awarded by COHC can be equal to or less than the amount awarded by the other grantor, up to \$200,000 maximum per organization.

This grant will not apply to any grants awarded by COHC. The purpose of this grant is to focus on program enhancement and sustainability.

How to Qualify

- Only grants from outside COHC will qualify and the award letter <u>must</u> be provided in the application process.
- The grant must provide support for the OHP population.
- The grant must provide support within the Central Oregon region.
- The outside grant must have been awarded between July 1, 2022 and July 31, 2023.
- Organizations must have a Tax ID number and required to submit a W-9.
- Grant activities must directly align with at least one <u>Future State Measure from the RHIP</u> in a meaningful way.
- The amount awarded to any one project/grant is up to \$200,000.
- The total amount that any one organization can receive, whether for one grant or several, is up to \$200,000.

What Is Not Eligible

- Grants awarded by Central Oregon Health Council.
- Projects that previously received match funding from the Impact Incentive Funds.
- Grants still in the Letter of Interest (LOI) stage.
- Grants that do not impact a RHIP Future State Measure.

- These funds cannot be used for:
 - Any product or service that can be billed to any health insurance plan currently or known in the future (durable medical equipment, screenings, medicines, nonemergency medical transportation, etc.)
 - o Administrative activities to support the delivery of covered services
 - Provider workforce or certification training
 - Individual rent/mortgage assistance and utilities (business costs associated with this project are allowable)
 - Brick and mortar construction
 - Project benefitting a single individual or single household
 - Health Information Technology that goes against PacificSource's one vendor policy
 - OHA and DHS cannot apply

- Expand project capacity
- Expand service area
- Extend project timeline
- Include additional prioritized populations
