Work upstream - understand the root causes

Build registry of providers by payors

Standardize the screening form

Come as a SME from your agencies' perspective

Provide necessary education to feel comfortable providing MH screening in dental offices

Seek out information from unique sources (i.e., draw from personal experiences, family experiences, school reports, ect.)

Map out where screenings can occur - where do they access care/share broadly.

Elevate learnings to other internal stakeholders
